## Overview

This bill makes changes to how interest rates are computed for judgments. It strikes provisions applicable only to judgments for or against the state or a political subdivision. Finally, it provides that the interest rates in this section are not applicable to judgment or awards under section 60A.0811-which sets the interest rate at 10 percent for breach of an insurance policy.
