- 1** **Prohibited practices.** Eliminates the prohibition against Minnesota postsecondary institutions entering into agreements to market credit cards to their undergraduate students. These institutions are still prohibited from transferring to credit card issuers, any of their students' contact information.
 - 2** **Repealer.** Repeals:
 - the requirement for postsecondary institutions in Minnesota to give students notice about the potential impact of criminal arrests, charges, or convictions on certain occupations and financial aid;
 - the requirement for public institutions to sell American-made clothing and apparel in their bookstores, to the extent possible; and
 - the requirement that public employers purchase or require employees to furnish uniform or protective accessories that are not made in America.
