Overview

This bill freezes tuition for Minnesota resident undergraduates attending any of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities or the University of Minnesota for all academic terms in fiscal years 2012 and 2013. After that time, it limits the annual increase in tuition for Minnesota resident undergraduates at public institutions to the increase in the consumer price index for the previous year.

- 1 Tuition increase limitations.** Beginning July 1, 2013, the year-to-year tuition increases for Minnesota resident undergraduate students at institutions of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities are limited to the increase in the consumer price index (CPI-U) for the previous calendar year.
- 2 Tuition increase limitations.** Beginning July 1, 2013, the year-to-year tuition increases for Minnesota resident undergraduate students at University of Minnesota campuses are limited to the increase in the consumer price index (CPI-U) for the previous calendar year.
- 3 Tuition freeze at Minnesota State Colleges and Universities.** Prohibits any increase in tuition for Minnesota resident undergraduate students at institutions of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities for academic terms beginning between July 1, 2011, and June 30, 2013.
- 4 Tuition freeze at University of Minnesota.** Prohibits any increase in tuition for Minnesota resident undergraduate students University of Minnesota campuses for academic terms beginning between July 1, 2011, and June 30, 2013.
