## Overview

This bill clarifies that the term "targeted misdemeanor" includes a domestic abuse no contact order under section 629.75. (In 2010, section 518B.01, subdivision 22 was repealed and recodified as section 629.75 (*see* Laws 2010, ch. 299).) Under current law, peace officers must fingerprint persons arrested for or convicted of a targeted misdemeanor. These records are then forwarded to the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension.
