- 1 Election of officers.** Strikes a requirement that the House of Representatives elect a first and second assistant sergeant-at-arms, a postmaster, and an assistant postmaster.
 - 2 Records retention.** Requires the Legislative Coordinating Commission to adopt a records retention policy by July 1, 2012, that applies to the House of Representatives, the Senate, and all other entities in the legislative branch.
 - 3 GIS Services.** Requires the executive director of the LCC to issue a request for proposal for geographic information services for the legislative branch. Specifies that these services may be provided by a state agency, a private vendor, or both, but that services relating to redistricting may not be provided by an executive branch agency.
