1 **Motor pools.** (a) Requires the Commissioner of Administration to consolidate the fleet of state agency passenger vehicles and trucks and to manage acquisition, replacement, fuel and maintenance of these vehicles.

(b) Requires the Commissioner to reduce the number of state-owned vehicles by 15 percent by June 30, 2015, compared to the number owned on July 1, 2011. Specifies steps that must be taken in furtherance of this mandated reduction.

(c) Authorizes the commissioner to delegate to another agency the authority to acquire or maintain vehicles.

"Agencies" subject to this section are all agencies in the executive branch, with exception of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities.

A "vehicle" for purposes of this section is a passenger motor vehicle and a pickup or panel truck up to one ton carrying capacity, but does not include vehicles used for public safety purposes.
