- 1** **Request for proposals.** Requires the commissioner of employment and economic development to issue requests for proposals (RFPs) for contracts for software and services to improve UI audit activities and payment of improper claims. Any new system must use more comprehensive and technologically advanced programs; use state of the art methods and technologies including predictive modeling, link analysis, and anomaly/outlier detection; be able to identify and report improper payments before the payments are made; include self-improving detection capabilities; leverage technology to make the UI system more transparent and cost-effective; and increase savings by maximizing the collection of revenues due and reducing or eliminating payouts of wrongful claims. The commissioner must enter into a contract by October 1, 2011. The contract must include performance-based vendor financing in which the vendor shares in the risk of the project's success.
