This bill establishes a gross misdemeanor penalty for offenders who repeatedly tamper with motor vehicles or commit related offenses. Tampering with a motor vehicle after previously being convicted two or more times of motor vehicle tampering, auto theft, receiving stolen property, possession of burglary or theft tools, or criminal damage to property will result in a gross misdemeanor penalty.
