Expands the gross misdemeanor-level crime of fourth degree assault to include assaults against utility employees and contractors as well as postal workers while they are involved in their professional duties. The assailant must have known the person was a utility/postal worker and the assault must cause demonstrable bodily harm. Effective date. August 1, 2011, for crimes committed on or after that date.
