Overview

This bill encourages the public higher education systems to offer guaranteed tuition plans to undergraduate students to provide stable tuition to undergraduate students.

- 1 Undergraduate tuition guarantee plan; MnSCU.** Encourages the board of trustees to offer a tuition plan for Minnesota resident students pursuing two-year and four-year degrees that holds tuition constant at the rate charged in the first semester. The plan must have stable tuition for the two years or four years that are necessary to complete the degree, and after which tuition may increase to the rate charged new enrolling students.
- 2 Undergraduate tuition guarantee plan; U of M.** Encourages the board of regents to offer a tuition plan for Minnesota resident students pursuing undergraduate degrees that holds tuition constant at the rate charged in the first semester. The plan must have stable tuition for the four years that are necessary to complete the degree, and after which tuition may increase to the rate charged new enrolling students.
