This bill authorizes local governments acquiring by lease or purchase public safety equipment for fire departments to use sole-source acquisition for used equipment if there is clearly and legitimately only one source and it is best to establish the price by direct negotiation.

It also allows a local government to issue certificates of indebtedness or capital notes to acquire new or used public safety equipment by lease for a term of up to 15 years. Under current law, the maximum term for a certificate or note is 10 years and is only for purchase, not leasing. It exempts the debt from debt limits and election requirements.
