## Overview

This bill includes provisions authorizing the sale and conveyance of certain lands administered by the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) and other provisions related to the administration of state land.

- **Deposit of fees.** Amends § 85.052, subd. 4. Requires mineral lease payments resulting from leases on lands within the Iron Range Off-Highway Vehicle Recreation Area to be deposited into the dedicated accounts from which the funds for the purchase of the lands were made.
- 2 Smoky Hills State Forest. Amends § 89.021, subd. 48. Technical.
- **Additions to state parks.** Expands the boundaries of Scenic State Park and William O'Brien State Park.
- **Deletion from state parks.** Removes land from Hayes Lake State Park.
- **Additions to state recreation areas.** Expands the boundaries of Greenleaf Lake State Recreation Area and the Iron Range Off-Highway Vehicle Recreation Area.
- **Addition to state forest.** Expands the boundary of the Smoky Hills State Forest.
- **Deletion from state forest.** Removes land from the Lost River State Forest (the land is added to the Roseau Lake Wildlife Management Area in the next section).
- **8** Addition to state wildlife management area. Adds a portion of lands currently in the Lost River State Forest to the Roseau Lake Wildlife Management Area.
- Mississippi River management plan. Exempts the historic village of Dayton from certain development standards and requirements applicable under the wild and scenic rivers program which the village is currently subject to. States that the village shall conform to the general shoreland development standards, except that marinas are prohibited and a portion of the wild and scenic rivers program requirements and standards still apply.

- 10 to 28 Sales. Permits public and private sales of certain DNR administered lands in locations as described in the bill.
- **Effective date.** States that sections 9 to 28 are effective the day following final enactment.
