Overview

This bill establishes a temporary Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) program that allows the department to enter into contracts with a construction manager/general contractor for parts of construction project administration. The program expires following ten construction manager/general contractor contracts.

- 1 Construction manager/general contractor data. Provides for data practices.
- 2 Construction manager/general contractor; definitions. Defines terms for the program.
- 3 Construction manager/general contractor; authority. Authorizes MnDOT to enter into contracts for a construction manager or general contractor, provides for contract cancellation, and specifies legislative reporting when such a contract is used.
- 4 Construction manager/general contractor; procedures. Establishes the process and various requirements governing evaluation and selection of a construction manager or general contractor by MnDOT. Provides for solicitation, requests for proposals, technical review committee evaluation, and contract negotiations.
- 5 Legislative reports on contracting. Requires interim and final legislative reports on the program.
