Overview

This bill makes primarily technical and clarifying changes to the body art technical licensing statute.

- Licensure requirements. Amends § 146B.03, subd. 4. Clarifies that an individual must complete 200 hours of supervised experience in each area for which the applicant is seeking licensure. Also provides that the required coursework must be completed within the year preceding application for licensure.
- **General.** Amends § 146B.04, subd. 1. Provides that guest artists must meet the requirement for specified coursework to be completed within one year prior to seeking a license.
- 3 Contamination standards. Amends § 146.06, subd. 5. Strikes a reference to a federal regulation. Now requires that contaminated waste stored on site cannot exceed the overflow level of any container.
- 4 Licensing fees. Amends § 146B.10, subd. 1, including the head note. Provides that the initial establishment license fee and the three year license renewal fee is \$1,000.
