Waste contracts. Current law contains a number of conditions that must be met before a state agency can enter into a contract with an outside vendor for services. Among these conditions is a finding that no current state employee is able and available to perform the services called for by the proposed contract.

This section authorizes the Commissioner of Administration to enter into or approve a state agency contract for waste removal without determining that no current state employee is able and available to perform the services called for by the contract.
