Overview

The statutes conditionally require the Minnesota Department of Management and Budget (MMB) to annually report to the legislature on the amount of federal funding that may be withheld if Minnesota were to discontinue implementation of the federal No Child Left Behind Act.

This bill repeals this reporting requirement.

Repealer. Repeals the requirement that the Minnesota Department of Management and Budget (MMB) annually report to the legislature on the amount of federal funding that may be withheld if the federal Department of Education did not approve Minnesota's proposed waiver requests and Minnesota were to discontinue implementation of the federal No Child Left Behind Act.
