Overview

This bill modifies the requirements for repeat background studies.

- 1 Licensed programs.** Amends §245C.04, subdivision 1. Requires a license holder to initiate a new background study on an individual who returns to a position after a 180 day absence. Current law requires this after a 45 day absence. Adds that if an individual has previously received a set aside for the program, the set aside continues if there is no new information discovered on the repeat background study to indicate the person poses a risk to the persons receiving services. Requires substitute caregivers to have a repeat background check at the time of each family child care license renewal.
