Overview

This bill extends the sunset date of various advisory councils.

- **1** Membership terms, compensation, removal and expiration. Amends § 254A.035, subd. 2. Extends the expiration date of the American Indian Advisory Council from June 30, 2012, to June 30, 2014, or in accordance with § 3D.21, whichever is later. This counciladvises the commissioner on developing policies and procedures relating to chemical dependency and the abuse of alcohol and other drugs by American Indians.
- 2 Citizens advisory council. Amends § 254A.04. Extends the expiration date of the council from June 30, 2012, to June 30 2014, or in accordance with § 3D.21, whichever is later. This council advises the commissioner on issues related to alcohol and other drug dependency and abuse.
- **3** State traumatic injury program. Amends § 256B.093, subd. 1. Extends the expiration date of the advisory council from June 30, 2012, to June 30, 2014, or in accordance with § 3D.21, whichever is later. This council provides recommendations to the commissioner regarding program and service needs of individuals with traumatic brain injuries.
- **4 Expiration.** Amends § 260.935, subd. 2. Extends the expiration date of the American Indian Child Welfare Advisory Council from June 30, 2012, to June 30, 2014, or in accordance with § 3D.21, whichever is later. This council is a component of the state and tribal contract for child welfare services.
