Permits law enforcement to take fingerprints from offenders arrested for any offense if the fingerprints are needed to resolve a file that is in suspense. A file is considered in suspense when the BCA cannot link a record with a booking because law enforcement did not collect fingerprints at the time of the booking. A common record that cannot be linked is a court disposition.
