Current Minnesota Statutes, section 16B.35, provides that an appropriation for construction or alteration of a state building may contain an amount up to one percent of the total appropriation for acquisition of works of art for the building or its grounds. This section places a \$100,000 cap on the percent for arts provision. The costs of artistic features that improve the safety of the building are not included in the \$100,000 limit. The \$100,000 limit does not apply to the State Capitol Building.
