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**Subject:** Shifting Regulatory Authority of Health Maintenance Organizations (HMOs)

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## Overview

- Commissioner of commerce or commissioner. Amends § 62D.02, subd. 3. Changes the definition of commissioner, as used throughout Minnesota Statutes, chapter 62D, to refer to the commissioner of commerce rather than the commissioner of health.
- **Supplemental benefits.** Amends § 62D.05, subd. 6. Removes a provision that directed the commissioner of health, when adopting rules for the regulation of HMOs, to consider the laws and rules enforced by the commissioner of commerce.
- **False representations.** Amends § 62D.12, subd. 1. Removes a provision that required HMO trade practices regulation to be enforced by the commissioner of health.
- 4 Revisor's instruction. Directs the revisor of statutes to make conforming changes throughout Minnesota Statutes, chapter 62D in order to switch references from the commissioner of health to the commissioner of commerce.
- **Effective date.** Provides that sections 1 to 4 of this bill are effective August 1, 2012.
