Overview

Current law prohibits school districts from beginning the school year before Labor Day unless an exception applies. This bill proposes to allow school districts to begin school before Labor Day but prohibits school from being held on the Thursday and Friday before Labor Day.

- 1 School calendar.** Allows a school district to begin school before Labor Day but prohibits the district from holding school on the Thursday and Friday immediately preceding Labor Day.

Makes this section effective for the 2012-2013 school year and later.
