Overview

This bill allows an exemption from licensing moratorium for certified adult foster care homes serving people with mental illness.

1 **Adult foster care homes serving people with mental illness; certification.** Amends § 245A.03 by creating subdivision 6a.

Paragraph (a) instructs the commissioner to develop a certification process by January 1, 2013.

Paragraph (b) sets out the requirements for certificates.

Paragraph (c) requires license holders seeking certification to submit a written request to the county in which the home is located.

Paragraph (d) requires compliance reviews by the county.

Paragraph (e) provides that denial of certification or removal of certification due to failure to comply with paragraph (b) is not appealable. Allows the license holder to request certification when the license holder is in compliance with paragraph (b).
