Overview

This bill clarifies license plate display requirements and limits the amount collected in fines for a violation. The changes go into effect August 1, 2012.

- 1 Other motor vehicles.** Narrows and clarifies required display of license plates on the front and rear of most passenger vehicles, so that the plates must be mounted either on the vehicle's bumper or in a location designed for license plate display. Sets the fine for a violation at \$20.
- 2 Surcharges on criminal and traffic offenders.** Prevents imposition of a court surcharge or additional surcharge for a violation of the license plate display provision (being changed in section 1 of the bill).
