Overview

This bill modifies existing law to provide that the *complete* terms of any agreement settling a dispute arising out an employment relationship involving an entity covered by the government data practices act is public data. Similarly, the bill requires that *all of the* specific reasons for an agreement must be disclosed if it involves the payment of more than \$10,000 of public money.

The bill also adds certain officials in political subdivisions to the law providing for public disclosure of data relating to a complaint or charge against the official. Existing provisions regulating the time when these data would become public are unchanged.
