The bill requires the Department of Revenue to pay CY 2011 LGA amounts to the cities that had their payments withheld because the cities did not meet the filing standards and guidelines established by the Office of the State Auditor (OSA) for filing financial reports, provided that the city files all missing documents by May 31, 2012. Current law required meeting the current reporting requirements in order to receive LGA.

The following cities did not file their annual financial reports by the normal deadline, or a second or extension deadline, and therefore did not receive all or part of their 2011 LGA payment. Cities indicated with an asterisk still have missing documents.
