Overview

Limits the authority of the Three Rivers Park District by allowing Hennepin County property taxes to be used only for projects and services that benefit the county.

- 1 **Use of funds (Three Rivers Park District).** Provides that the Three Rivers Park District board may use proceeds of its levy derived from properties in Hennepin County only for park services and projects within the county, or for a portion of the cost of projects and services performed partly within and partly outside Hennepin County, in proportion to the county's share of the benefits received. Explicitly provides that the district board may pay for operation and maintenance of the Coon Rapids dam.
