Overview

This bill reduces the limitations period for filing certain types of civil actions.

- 1 Statutes of limitation; Antitrust.** Reduces the limitation period for claims alleging a violation of Minnesota's antitrust provisions ("combinations in restraint of trade") from four years to two years of the date upon which the cause of action arose.
- 2 Four-year limitation.** Reduces the general statute of limitations period that applies to a variety of types of civil claims from the current six-year period to four years.
- 3 Effective date.** Provides that the new limitations periods established in this bill apply to causes of action occurring or accruing on or after the effective date of the bill.
