### Overview

- 1**      **Performance tracking system.** (a) To comply with federal reporting requirements, directs the adult basic education performance tracking system to use longitudinal data to track program outcomes, including data on the extent to which participation in a diversionary work program, Minnesota family investment program, and food support and training program is reduced as a result of learners participating in an adult basic education program.
- (c) Requires an adult basic education program provider to notify a program participant asked to provide his or her social security number that the participant's social security number will be shared with the office of higher education and the department of human services, among other entities, in order to meet the reporting requirements in paragraph (a) of this section.
- Makes this section immediately effective and applicable through the 2020-2021 school year.
