Overview

H.F. 125 reduces appropriations in fiscal year 2011 for the executive branch, the legislature, and the constitutional offices. \$200 million in cuts to the executive branch must be allocated by the commissioner of management and budget (MMB). Other cuts are unspecified amounts. Provides an immediate effective date.

Section

- Fiscal year 2011 reductions. Directs the MMB commissioner to reduce executive branch spending in fiscal year 2011 by \$200 million and to allocate that reduction to the agencies of the executive branch. No reductions may be allocated to general or special education funding and the University of Minnesota and the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities funding may not be further reduced in fiscal year 2011. Requires the commissioner to report to the legislature on the agency reductions that apply only to fiscal year 2011.
- **Reductions, legislature, constitutional officers.** Makes unspecified reductions in general fund appropriations in fiscal year 2011 for the senate, house of representatives, the governor and lieutenant governor, the state auditor, the attorney general and the secretary of state.
