This bill would extend and expand the driver's license reinstatement diversion pilot project that the legislature established in 2009. Currently, the program is set to expire on June 30, 2011, and only cities are eligible to participate. Under the bill, the program would be extended to June 30, 2013, and counties would be eligible to participate.

The program provides diversion driver's licenses to offenders who have had their licenses suspended and agree to pay their outstanding fees, fines, and surcharges back in installments and meet other requirements required under law or established in program guidelines.
