Overview

Prohibits requirements for fire sprinklers in single family homes.

Single family dwelling; fire sprinklers. Precludes the State Building Code, State Fire Code, or a political subdivision from requiring the installation of fire sprinklers, sprinkler system components, or automatic fire extinguishing equipment or devices in new or existing single-family detached dwellings. Specifies that this provision does not affect or limit requirements for smoke or fire detectors, alarms, or components. Effective the day following final enactment.
