### Overview

Allows physically able resident students temporarily placed in a care and treatment program to participate in district extracurricular activities on the same basis as other students enrolled in the district.

#### Section

- 1 Board control of extracurricular activities.** Directs a school board to allow all physically able resident pupils temporarily placed in a care and treatment program to remain eligible to fully participate in district extracurricular activities on the same basis as other students.
