or limited elevator constructor; requires a written and oral examination to determine competence prior to licensure; provides for fees under the current fee schedule in chapter 326B; sets out exemptions from licensing and provides for reciprocity for licensure in other states.

- Conflict of laws. States that persons licensed under the elevator constructor/contractor licensing laws are not subject to the Minnesota Electrical Act.
- License, registration, and renewal fees; expiration. Makes necessary changes in the Minnesota Electrical Act to reflect new language for elevator constructors and contractors.
- **Exemptions from licensing.** Makes necessary changes in the Minnesota Electrical Act to reflect the new provisions for elevator constructors and contractors.
- **Repealer.** Repeals statutory language and rules that are in conflict or not applicable under the new elevator constructor/contractor licensing structure.
- **Effective date.** July 1, 2013.
