Overview

Adds students with disabilities who transfer between public schools as a reasonable accommodation to reduce barriers to educational access as an exception to the Minnesota State High School League transfer rule that generally makes student athletes who transfer between high schools without changing their residence ineligible for one year of varsity competition in the enrolling high school.

Section

- 1** **Rules for open enrollees.** (c) Makes a student with an individualized education program or a 504 plan who transfers from one public school to another public school as a reasonable accommodation to reduce barriers to educational access immediately eligible to participate in Minnesota State High School League-sponsored varsity competition on the same basis as other students in the school to which the student transfers.

Makes this section effective immediately and applicable to all student transfers initiated after that date.
