- 1 Autism spectrum disorder statewide strategic plan implementation.** Requires the commissioners of education, employment and economic development, health, and human services to implement the autism spectrum disorder statewide strategic plan developed by the Autism Spectrum Disorder Task Force. Requires the commissioners to work with stakeholders, prepare progress reports, and provide two opportunities per year for interested parties to provide input on implementation.
- 2 Repealer.** Repeals the 2011 law creating the Autism Spectrum Disorder Task Force. Under current law, the task force expires June 30, 2015.
