Overview

Amends the state Human Rights Act to prohibit discrimination based on family status or status as a family caregiver.

Section

- 1** **Family caregiver.** Provides a definition of “family caregiver.”
- 2** **Labor organization.** Expands coverage of antidiscrimination protections to familial status and status as a family caregiver.
- 3** **Employer.** Expands coverage of antidiscrimination protections to familial status and status as a family caregiver.
- 4** **Employment agency.** Expands coverage of antidiscrimination protections to familial status and status as a family caregiver.
- 5** **Employer, employment agency, or labor organization.** Expands coverage of antidiscrimination protections related to the collection of or request for information, to familial status and status as a family caregiver.
