Overview

This bill changes the definitions of “preschooler” and “school age” for purposes of family and group family day care age classifications and adult/child ratios.

Section

- 1** **Family day care and group family day care child age classifications.** Amends § 245A.02, subd. 19. Paragraph (e) changes the definition of “preschooler” from a child who is 24 months old up to the age of being eligible to enter kindergarten within the next four months, to be to a child who is 24 months old up to school age.

Paragraph (f) changes the definition of “school age” to conform with the new definition of “preschooler.”
