Overview

The bill provides funds from the consolidated chemical dependency treatment fund to grants to recovery schools to pay the salaries of licensed chemical dependency counselors.

Section

- 1 Recovery school programs.** Paragraph (a) appropriates \$400,000 from the consolidated chemical dependency treatment fund in fiscal year to the commissioner of human services for grants of up to \$100,000 to qualifying recovery school programs to pay salaries for licensed chemical dependency counselors. Establishes a base budget of \$100,000 for each qualifying school.

Paragraph (b) defines “qualifying recovery school program” as an academic setting that meets graduation requirements and provides services to students recovering from substance abuse or dependence.
