Overview

Section

- 1 Crime defined. Specifies that the misdemeanor, gross misdemeanor, and felony crime for failure to provide support must be court-ordered support.
 - **Effective date.** This section applies to crimes committed on or after August 1, 2014.
- 2 Conditions of work release; probation violation. Specifies that the payment of child support that is required for work release or a probation violation when there has been a felony violation of support must be court-ordered child support.
 - **Effective date**. This section applies to crimes committed on or after August 1, 2014.
- **Defense.** Adds that an affirmative defense to criminal liability for non-payment of support is for court-ordered child support.
 - **Effective date.** This section applies to crimes committed on or after August 1, 2014.
