- 1 Practice of professional engineering.** Lists activities and terms reserved exclusively to licensed professional engineers.
- 2 Practice of land surveying.** Clarifies meaning of land surveying.
- 3 Board established.** Strikes obsolete language.
- 4 Issuance.** Strikes obsolete language.
- 5 Needs of physically disabled, inclusion in examination.** Strikes obsolete language.
- 6 Engineer, land surveyor, geoscientist; in training.** Streamlined language.
- 7 Reinstatement of expired license or certificate.** Specifies 48 as the maximum number of professional development hours needed as part of the process of reinstating an expired license or certificate.
- 8 Requirements.** Dedicates two hours of a required minimum of 24 hours of professional development hours to ethics.
- 9 Programs and activities.** Limits professional development hours earned to those earned in the biennium; clarifies they are not to be used toward carryover.
- 10 Reports and records.** Increases from two years to four years, the length of time after the end of the licensure period that licensees or certificate holders must maintain records of

courses and activities.

- 11**      **Cease and desist orders.** Authorizes the board to issue cease and desist orders for the unauthorized use of specified titles.
- 12**      **Seal.** Strikes obsolete language.
- 13**      **Repealers.** Repeals obsolete language.
