### Overview

This bill amends insurance requirements and vehicle types for limousines.

#### Section

- 1** **Limousine insurance.** Raises the minimum required level of per accident insurance for each limousine, from \$300,000 to \$1.5 million.
- 2** **Limousine.** Broadens the definitions of “limousine” in the chapter of statutes on vehicle registration, to no longer specify vehicle type and allow up to 15 people with the driver.
- 3** **Plates.** Makes conforming and technical changes.
- 4** **Insurance.** Raises minimum insurance coverage levels for limousines operated with special limousine plates, to at least \$1.5 million per person in an accident. Makes conforming and technical changes.
- 5** **Definition.** Broadens the definition of “limousine” in the section of statutes on limousine regulation to no longer specify vehicle type and allow up to 15 people with the driver.
