Overview

Requires districts to give equal weight of all dual course credits. Strikes language allowing postsecondary institutions participating in the postsecondary enrollment options program to advertise, recruit or solicit high school students on educational or programmatic grounds only.

Section

- 1** **Grade point average weighting.** Defines dual credit courses and requires districts to give equal weight to the grades of all dual credit courses in determining students' GPA.
- 2** **Enrollment priority.** Strikes language allowing postsecondary institutions participating in the postsecondary enrollment options program to advertise, recruit, or solicit high school students to enroll in a postsecondary institution program only on educational or programmatic grounds.
