Overview

This bill requires certain transit providers to provide free transit service on the day of a state general election.

Section

- 1** **Transit service on election day.** Requires recipients of state assistance for fixed-route transit service in greater Minnesota to provide free transit service on the date of the state general election.
- 2** **Transit service on election day.** Requires the Metropolitan Council to provide free regular-route transit service on the date of the state general election. This section includes transit services operating under the replacement service program (473.388), and pursuant to a management contract (473.405, subd. 12).
- 3** **Appropriations; election day transit service.** Appropriates money in an amount that reflects the lost fare revenues resulting from the free transit services required by the bill.
