## Bill Summary

**FILE NUMBER:** H.F. 3072  
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**Subject:** Department of Public Safety unsession; motor vehicle regulations

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### Overview

This bill contains transportation-related “unsession” provisions for the Department of Public Safety, as well as provisions on recording speeding violations and special permits for mini trucks.

#### Section

- 1 Disability plates; application.** Removes unnecessary cross references (for terms that are defined chapter-wide).
- 2 Towing violation a misdemeanor; exceptions.** Makes a conforming change.
- 3 Collector’s vehicle, classic car plate.** Permits the Department of Public Safety to use national standards, instead of a list in statute, in determining which vehicles can be registered as a collector’s vehicle.
- 4 Plates; design, visibility, periods of issuance.** Removes unnecessary cross references (for terms that are defined chapter-wide).
- 5 Amateur radio license; special plates, rules.** Removes unnecessary cross references (for terms that are defined chapter-wide).
- 6 Firefighters; special plates, rules.** Removes unnecessary cross references (for terms that are defined chapter-wide).
- 7 National Guard; special plates, rules.** Removes unnecessary cross references (for terms that are defined chapter-wide).

- 18** **Appropriation; special account.** Eliminates a legislative report on use of funds from a child passenger restraint and education account, which is replaced with a directive to provide such information on request.
- 19** **Definitions.** Makes a conforming change.
- 20** **Certain convictions not recorded.** Extends the sunset date on a provision that prevents some speeding violations from appearing on a driver's record, so that until August 1, 2015, a violation of up to ten miles per hour over the limit in a 60 m.p.h. zone is not recorded (at which time only violations of up to five miles per hour over the limit are not recorded).
- 21** **Effective date.** Eliminates a July 31, 2014, sunset on authority for local units of government to issue special permits that allow operation of mini trucks on roads under their jurisdiction.
- 22** **Repealer.** Repeals:
- § 168.0422 – authority for officers to stop a vehicle bearing special registration “whiskey” plates (which was found unconstitutional)
  - § 168.055 – requirements on safety chains and vehicle speeds when towing

- ▶ § 299D.04 – authority for the Department of Public Safety to participate in a nationwide police communication system
- ▶ § 299D.05 – authority on a radio repeater station in Wisconsin
- ▶ § 609B.202 – conforming change for repeal of § 169.11
