Overview

Allows the board of teaching to issue an out-of-state teacher licensure applicant a Minnesota license if their scope of license is no more than two grade levels, instead of one grade level less than a similar Minnesota license.

Section

- 1 Applicants licensed in other states.** (b) Directs the board of teaching to issue a teaching license to an otherwise qualified out-of-state applicant whose scope of license is no more than two, instead of one, grade levels less than a similar Minnesota license.
- (c) Directs the board of teaching to issue up to three temporary one-year teaching licenses to an otherwise qualified out-of-state applicant to teach the same content field and grade levels for which the applicant was licensed if the scope of the out-of-state license is no more than two grade levels, instead of one grade level less than a similar Minnesota license.
