Overview

Requires postsecondary institutions that admit a high school student participating in the postsecondary enrollment options program to also admit an otherwise qualified postsecondary student who is a veteran if the veteran can demonstrate that the institution's enrollment time line was not practicable for the veteran.

Section

1 Enrollment priority. (b) Requires postsecondary institutions that enroll a secondary student in a course under the state's postsecondary enrollment options program to also enroll an otherwise qualified and enrolled postsecondary student who qualifies as a veteran if the veteran can demonstrate to the postsecondary institution's satisfaction that the institution's enrollment time lines were not practicable for the veteran.

Makes this section effective July 1, 2014.
