Overview

The 2012 legislature amended the laws governing teacher preparation programs to require teacher candidates to pass a basic skills exam before receiving an initial teaching license. Previously, the Minnesota Board of Teaching had the option of issuing up to three temporary one-year teaching licenses to new teachers who failed the basic skills exam so they might have additional time to take and pass the exam. This bill proposes to remove the requirement that teacher candidates pass a basic skills test.

1 **License and rules.** (b) Strikes language directing the Board of Teaching to require persons to pass a basic skills exam as a condition of receiving an initial teaching license.

Makes technical changes.

Makes this section immediately effective and applicable to any teacher candidate who has not yet passed the basic skills exam.

Teacher and support personnel qualifications. (b) Strikes language directing the Board of Teaching to require persons to pass a basic skills exam as a condition of receiving an initial teaching license; and strikes language requiring teacher preparation programs and institutions to provide remedial assistance to teacher candidates who did not pass the basic skills exam. Also strikes language directing the Board of Teaching to annually report information about candidates' basic skills scores to the legislature.
