- **1 Federal contingency planning.** Requires that as part of its budget presentation, each executive agency that receives federal funds include an analysis of implications for the agency if federal funds are dramatically reduced or eliminated. Specifies contents of this analysis.
- 2 **Report on loss of federal funds.** Requires the commissioner of MMB to report to the chairs and ranking minority members of the Senate Finance and House Ways and Means committees on immediate implications for state agency budgets if federal funds are dramatically reduced or eliminated, either on a short-term or long-term basis. Requires a report within 30 days of the event that triggers the federal government's inability or unwillingness to meet prior level of commitments to state agencies.
