Overview

Under current statute, school districts are prohibited from beginning the school year before Labor Day unless the district needs to accommodate either a construction or remodeling project of \$400,000 or more affecting a school facility or an agreed upon school schedule with a district in an adjoining state.

School calendar. Strikes language prohibiting school districts in most circumstances from beginning the school year before Labor Day.
